



Dear Friends and Family,

Trans World Radio (TWR) has asked us to be in Benin on May 1, 2007 to work on a new transmitting site to reach West Africa. The Benin transmitting site will have a potential listening audience of 195 million people, of which 45 million are unreached.¹ More details can be found in the enclosed FAQ.

In order to be on site by May 1, we need a support team that will pray, encourage and give financially. Our deepest thanks go to the many people who have already joined this team by praying, encouraging and giving. To those who have not joined we want to inform you of the opportunities and give you a chance to join the team.

The first and most important opportunity is that of prayer. It has been said that the real work of the ministry is prayer. It is essential that people regularly commit time and energy to pray for the Benin transmitting site and us.

The second opportunity is for people who will encourage us via letters, phone calls, packages, emails and trips to join us in the work. Do not imagine that we are above discouragement, fatigue and selfish whims. It is important that there are people to encourage, spiritually refresh and help us maintain our confidence in God's sufficiency.

The last opportunity is for people to give financially. It costs \$6,000 per month for TWR to have our family of five serving in West Africa.² TWR requires us to find individuals, churches and organizations that will donate this money to cover our expenses. There is an opportunity for people to give monthly through Trans World Radio to cover our monthly expenses. One-time gifts are also welcome.³

As mentioned above, many people have already joined our team. Because of this, approximately 30% of the \$6,000 per month is already covered.⁴

¹Most of these unreached people have never had the chance to hear and respond to the Gospel.

²The monthly expenses break down as follows: Living Allowance 48%, Health & Pension 17%, Housing 14%, Taxes 8%, Travel 5%, Education 4% and Other 4%.

³In addition, it will cost \$30,000 to move our family to Benin, purchase a vehicle and outfit our house. Any money received prior to our departure will go to our Equipment Fund to cover these one-time expenses. You may also give one-time gifts directly to our Equipment Fund anytime. For this reason we encourage those who want to give monthly to start immediately.
